



## Delivered Terms

### 3 DDU – Delivered duty unpaid (named place)

The seller has to bear all the costs (excluding duties, taxes and other official charges payable) and risks needed to bring the goods to a specific point of destiny.

The seller has fulfilled his obligations when the goods have been made available at the named point and place.

If the parties wish to include in the seller's obligations some of the costs payable on moving the goods (such as CESS) this should be made clear by adding the words Delivered duty unpaid, CESS paid (named place).

<b>The Seller must;</b>	<b>The Buyer must;</b>
Provide goods in conformity with the contract	Pay the price stipulated in the contract
Transport the goods to the point of destination	Pay all taxes, duties and other charges incurred on the cargo (including CESS, VAT etc)
